#### I. Years of Enrollment:

Minimum years of enrollment: 4 years (5 years for Veterinary Medicine)

Can be extended for two more years (not including two years' intermission)

## II. Minimum graduation credits: <u>136</u> credits (excluding PE credits).

### III. University Required Courses and Credits:

- 1. Physical Education (PE) Course: 2 credits, not included in graduation credits. Additional credits earned from PE courses are capped at 2 and will count as credits from various departments. Student Athletes with outstanding sports achievements will be handled according to the relevant regulations of the Office of Physical Education and Sports.
- 2. English Proficiency Requirement: 0 credit.
- 3. General Education: 28 credits
  - i.Core Competencies: at least 3 credits. International students do not need to take the "Information Literacy" course.
  - ii.Language Competencies: (at least 8 credits)
    - Native Language and Literature: 4 credits

    - Foreign Language: at least 4 credits and at most 6 credit

iii.Domain Competencies: at least 10 credits

- Humanistic Domain, Social Science Domain, and Natural Domain: at least one course in each Domain, total at least 6 credits.
- Integrated Domain: at least 4 credits.
- For National Defense Education courses, only credits of 1 course can be counted toward general education credits.
- Our program belongs to the area of <u>Law & Politics</u>, therefore, only one course from this area will be recognized.

iv.Extra credits can be counted toward the graduation credits.
