Regulations for the Review of Graduate Student Scholarships and Grants in the Department of Law, National Chung Hsing University

- Article 1 These Regulations are formulated based on the "National Chung Hsing University Graduate Scholarship and Financial Aid Implementation Regulations."
- Article 2 The graduate scholarships and financial aid of the Department are divided into two types:
 - 1. **Scholarships**: Awarded to graduate students with excellent academic performance upon admission and during their studies or outstanding research achievements.
 - 2. **Financial Aid**: Provided to the following categories of graduate students:
 - Teaching Assistants: Students assisting in course-related practical work;
 financial aid is provided according to the "National Chung Hsing University
 Teaching Assistant System Implementation Guidelines."
 - Administrative Assistants: Students assisting with administrative tasks;
 financial aid is provided according to Article 8 of the "National Chung Hsing University Graduate Scholarship and Financial Aid Implementation Regulations."
- Article 3 Graduate students who fail to effectively assist with teaching, administrative tasks, or other related matters within the department, or who are subjected to disciplinary action involving a demerit or higher penalty under university regulations, shall be restricted from applying for or shall have their scholarships and grants suspended.
- Article 4 Scholarships and financial aid are granted from September to the following July for new students, and from August to the following July for continuing students. The scholarship and financial aid amounts may be adjusted on a monthly basis.
- Article 5 The Graduate Student Scholarship and Grant Review Committee of the Department shall be chaired by the Department Chair as the convener and composed of four full-time faculty members elected by the Department Affairs Meeting. The committee is responsible for handling the application and allocation of graduate student scholarships and grants.
- Article 6 These Regulations shall be implemented after being passed by the Department Affairs Meeting and submission to the President for ratification. The same procedure shall apply to any amendments.
