Implementation Guidelines for Interdisciplinary Specializations, Department of Law, National Chung Hsing University

Approved by the Department of Law Curriculum Committee on January 7, 2025 Approved by the University Curriculum Committee on March 25, 2025

I. In accordance with the *National Chung Hsing University Implementation Regulations for Interdisciplinary Specializations*, the Department of Law (hereinafter referred to as "the Department") has established these guidelines to encourage students to engage in autonomous learning, provide greater flexibility in course selection and interdisciplinary learning opportunities, and assist students in developing a second area of expertise.

II. Definition of Interdisciplinary Specialization

An interdisciplinary specialization refers to a program proposed by academic departments (degree programs) or colleges within the university. Such programs must include foundational core knowledge of the relevant field, with a total credit requirement of approximately 30 credits (minimum 28 credits, maximum 32 credits). Students completing an interdisciplinary specialization must satisfy both the graduation requirements and credit requirements of their own department and the credit requirements of the interdisciplinary specialization in order to have the specialization indicated on their diploma.

III. For Department of Law Students Enrolling in Interdisciplinary Specializations Offered by Other Departments/Degree Programs/Colleges

A. Application Process

Please complete the application form and submit it to the department within the specified deadline. After the department reviews and approves the application, it will be sent to the Department of Interdisciplinary Studies (degree program) or the college for review. After passing the review by both parties, it will be sent to the Registration Office for approval before admission to the Interdisciplinary Studies program.

B. Study Requirements

- 1. University-required courses and credits: Students must complete all university-required courses and credits.
- 2. **Department courses and credits:** Students must complete the courses and credits listed in the "Required Courses for Department of Law Students" table, including compulsory, restricted elective, and elective courses within the Department.
- 3. **Interdisciplinary specialization courses and credits:** Students must complete 28–32 credits of interdisciplinary specialization courses. If any courses overlap with the Department's graduation requirements, the offering department/college will designate related elective courses to fulfill the specialization credit requirements.
- 4. Students who have completed the university, departmental, and interdisciplinary specialization course requirements and earned the credits—meeting the minimum total graduation credits as specified in the attached table—will have the specialization noted on their diploma.
- C. If a student is unable to complete the interdisciplinary specialization, they may withdraw from it, but must still meet the original graduation requirements for their admission year. Credits earned from the specialization may be counted toward the maximum number of credits from other departments allowed under the graduation requirements for that admission year.

- IV. Matters not covered in these guidelines shall be handled in accordance with the university's academic regulations and related provisions.
- V. These guidelines shall be implemented upon approval by the University Curriculum Committee, and the same procedure shall apply to any amendments.

In case of any dispute, the explanation should be based on the Chinese version.
